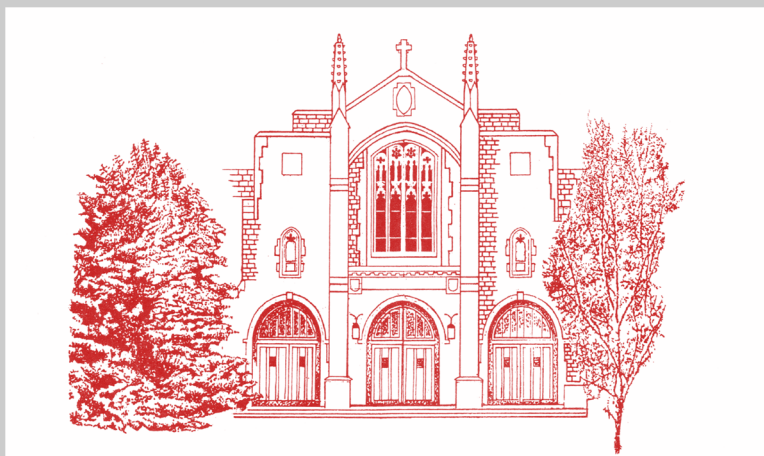

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Item 1

April 26, 2026- Third Sunday of Easter

EASTER DUTY – After they have been initiated into the Most Holy Eucharist, all the faithful are bound by the obligation of receiving Holy Communion at least once a year.

This precept must be fulfilled during the Easter season, unless for a good reason it is fulfilled at another time of the year. By special indult, in the United States, the time period for fulfilling this precept has been extended to include the period beginning the First Sunday of Lent (February 22,2026) to Pentecost (May 24, 2026).

Item 2

You may turn in your Lenten Offering Folders. If you are using a check please make it out to Sacred Heart. All the money collected will be turned over to Bridge for Life after Easter. If you are using a check please make the check out to SACRED HEART of JESUS.

Item 3

You may still donate toward the expense associated with the purchasing of church flowers and decorations for Holy Week and Easter. All contributions are greatly accepted. However, if your donation is \$30 or more your name and the name of the deceased person or persons in whose memory you made the donation, or in whose honor you made the donation will be printed in a special list in the bulletin after Easter. Thank you in advance for your generous response to this cause. Everyone always remarks that our church is beautifully decorated but besides the time and talent it takes to do so it costs money, and things now are even more costly than they were in the past. Please be generous in this collection so that we can give our best to the Lord as we celebrate the great day of His Resurrection.

**CHILDREN'S LITURGY OF THE
WORD (CLOW) 2026**



"Sometimes, moreover, if the place itself and the nature of the community permit, it will be appropriate to celebrate the Liturgy of the Word, including a homily, with the children in a separate, but not too distant room. Then, before the Eucharistic Liturgy begins, the children are led to the place where the adults have meanwhile celebrated their own liturgy of the word."

The above permission, which appeared in 1973, lies behind a phenomenon which has emerged in many Catholic parishes over the past few years, namely the celebration of a separate Children's Liturgy of the Word (CLOW) during Sunday Mass.

What is CLOW?

During mass, after the opening prayer, children are invited to go to the church hall to hear the readings of the day proclaimed and explained in age-appropriate language. The children re-join their families during the preparation of the gifts at the offertory.

Younger children are often accompanied by their parents.

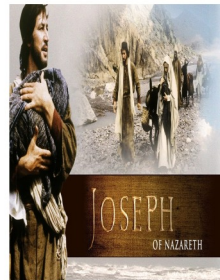

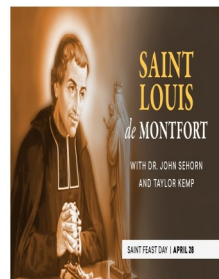
