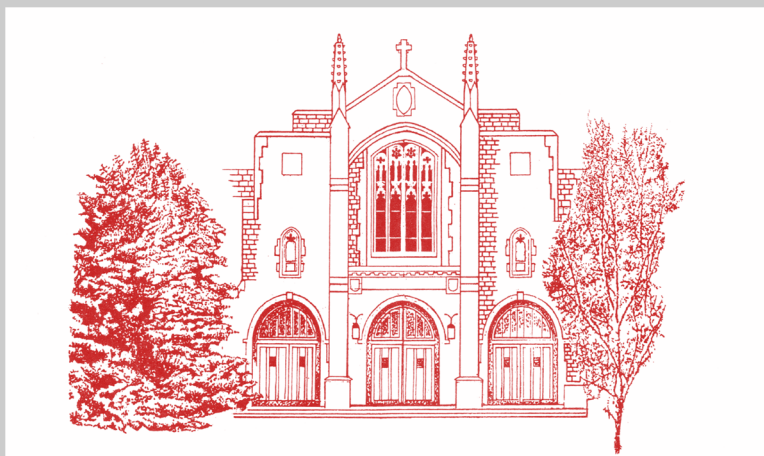

**CHILDREN'S LITURGY OF THE
WORD (CLOW) 2026**

"Sometimes, moreover, if the place itself and the nature of the community permit, it will be appropriate to celebrate the Liturgy of the Word, including a homily, with the children in a separate, but not too distant room. Then, before the Eucharistic Liturgy begins, the children are led to the place where the adults have meanwhile celebrated their own liturgy of the word."

The above permission, which appeared in 1973, lies behind a phenomenon which also emerged in many Catholic parishes over the past few years, namely the celebration of a separate Children's Liturgy of the Word (CLOW) during Sunday Mass.

What is CLOW? During mass, after the opening prayer, children are invited to go to the church hall to hear the readings of the day proclaimed and explained in age-appropriate language. The children rejoin their families during the preparation of the gifts at the offertory. Younger children are often accompanied by their parents.

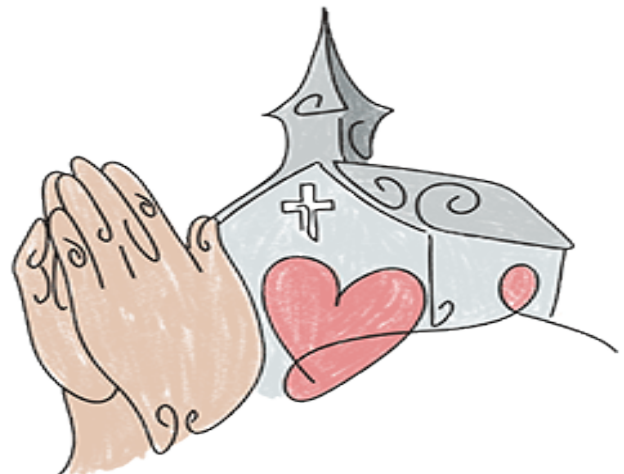
