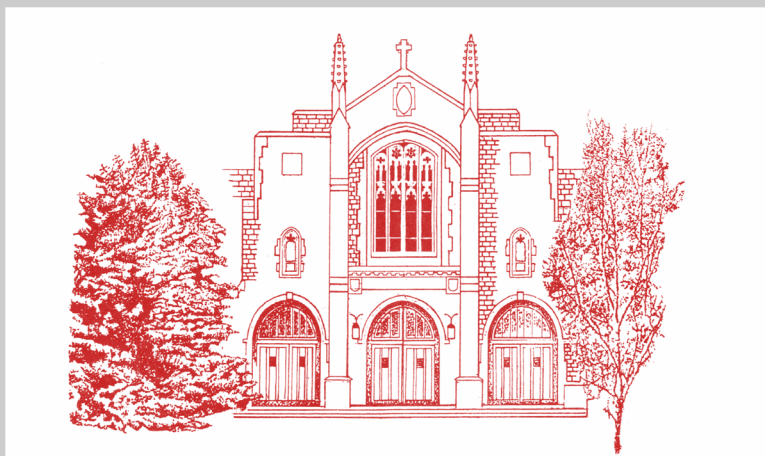

As summer approaches and many are off to their summer homes or for longer periods away from the parish..... 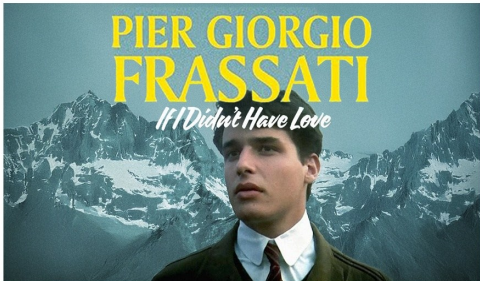

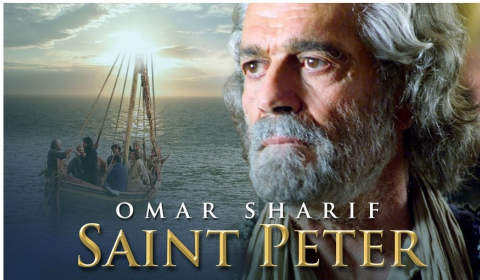
