FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Item 4

As summer begins and many are off to their summer homes or for longer periods are away from the parish..... Please remember that the work of the parish takes place 24 hours a day-7 days a week-365 days a year. Even though you might not be present at a particular Sunday or holy day Mass, or you may be away for the summer the parish depends on your weekly contributions to meet its bills and carry out its mission. **Please send in your weekly envelopes or consider signing up for online giving- this takes the burden off you to remember to send in your make up contributions and helps us to better plan our cash flow.**

Item 5

We need to replace the electric votive stands in our church. The votive stands we have are among the first that came out when electric candles became more common in churches. Our stands do not have an automatic shut off mechanism thus they have to be turned off manually otherwise they would stay lit continually. I had an electrician look at them to see if we could have timers put on them, but he said it was not possible. Also, the votives we have are not energy efficient and pull a lot of electrical power.

The new stands that I have seen in various catalogs all cost in the range of \$7, 200. 00 We have 6 votive stands presently and need to add candles at the Shrine of St. Carlo.

I am in the process of researching the situation and the various options we might have.
