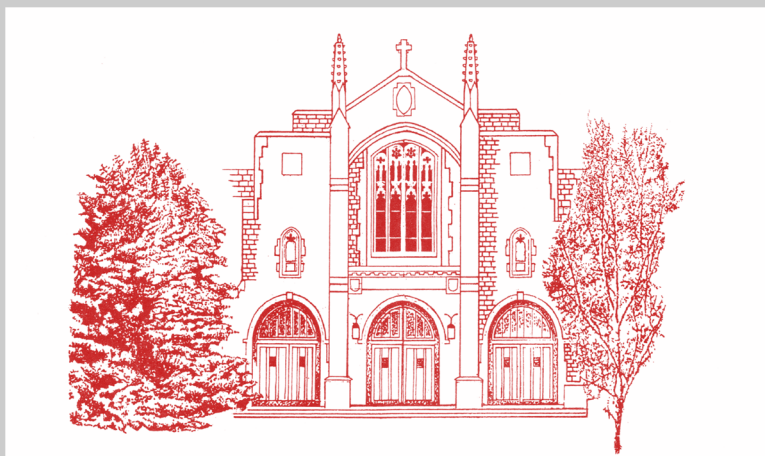

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

The month of July is dedicated to the Precious Blood of Jesus.

Item 1

Many have asked about the sign in front of the church that has the American flag on it and the words **250 HOURS of ADORATION** and have asked what it means. We are seeking 250 people to commit to one hour of Adoration for the intentions of our nation as we celebrate our semiquincentennial.

Can you commit to one hour? If you like, you can commit to more than one hour, but I would like to offer to Our Lord, from our parish, prayers for our nation totaling 250 hours in honor of our nation's semiquincentennial. My wish is that we can accomplish this by the end of the month of July.

I have been told by many of our long-time parishioners that the Church used to have electronic bells/ carillon system. If you remember the bells /carillon on our church please let me know. As of this writing, no one has come to me to tell me that they remember the bells on our church. So, my question remains unanswered- did we or did we not have working electronic bells on the church? We did find speakers on the roof of the church and are guessing these might be from an old electronic bell system, but we are not sure. Item 6

We need to replace the electric votive stands in our church. The votive stands we have are among the first that came out when electric candles became more common in churches. Our stands do not have an automatic shut off mechanism thus they have to be turned off manually otherwise they would stay lit continually. I had an electrician look at them to see if we could have timers put on them, but he said it was not possible. Also, the votives we have are not energy efficient and pull a lot of electrical power.

The new stands that I have seen in various catalogs all cost in the range of \$7,200.00. We have 6 votive stands presently and need to add candles at the Shrine of St. Carlo.

I am still in the process of researching the situation and the various options we might have.

The ACA goal for 2026 is \$75,286.00 and we are already OVER GOAL! THANK YOU!

As of July 13, **173** parishioners have already responded to the 2026 ACA and pledged \$128,783.00 and paid \$115,766.00.

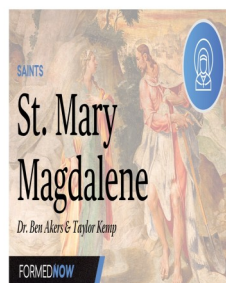
St. James the Greater | Catholic Saints
